Languages

We accept submissions in Spanish and English.

Guidelines

Each manuscript must comply with the structure described in the journal's Instructions for Authors and with the general guidelines on the presentation of abstracts, keywords and graphic aspects. The journal's citation style is Vancouver.

Evaluation process

Each manuscript will be evaluated under a double-blind peer review system. Authors will be responsible for making any modifications or corrections that arise from this process to achieve publication.

Publication window and visibility

This special edition is scheduled to be published in volume 42 of the journal in 2026, in Open Access. Likewise, the published articles will be indexed in all international databases and systems in which Acta Neurológica Colombiana is included.

- **Call for papers opens:** 2 February 2026
- **Submission guidelines:** From 1 March to 1 August 2026
- **Average peer review time:** One quarter
- **Planned publication window:** 2026
